25/26 - 0401 Apologies

25/26 – 0402 Declaration of Interests

25/26 – 0403 Minutes of Previous meeting

- a) The minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on Wednesday 11th March 2026 were reviewed and agreed as an accurate and true record and signed accordingly.

25/26 - 0404 Report from Ward Councillors

Cllr Nigel Sherwood gave an update stating that outline planning permission had been granted for the Data Centre at Elsham. The project has committed to securing 30% of work from the local supply chain, there will be up to 5,000 jobs in the construction phase and 600 permanent jobs. The site will cover 430 acres that is currently farmland, but as part of the construction 37 acres of glasshouses will be built, with an associated 65 permanent jobs.

The project is also ringfencing £1mil for play and recreation facilities in the 8 parishes it borders, Saxby All Saints is one of the parishes that will benefit from this.
